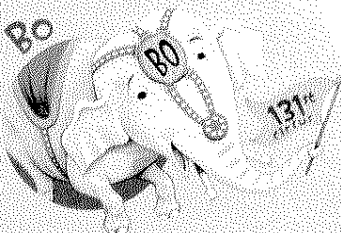

Thank you for making this a pleasant experience and I look forward to working with you in the future.

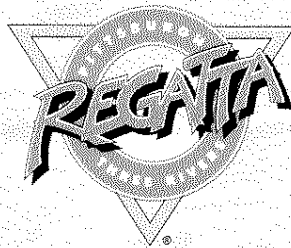

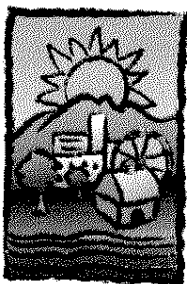
